Project Description: The improvements under this project consist of a complete redesign and new construction of the Park Facility to include a 42,000 square foot Intergenerational center which will house the Park programs and Austin Hepburn Center. The exterior of the park will include a PAL Building (Office/Storage/Restroom/Concession), playground with shade cover, walking path, multi-purpose field, tennis courts, and on-site parking for 114 vehicles.



PHASE II – DEMOLITION AND MULTI PURPOSE FIELD CONSTRUCTION

- Phase I Grand Opening took place on September 17, 2016
- Operation on Intergenerational building Began September 19, 2016
- Phase II will consist of the southern portion of the site which will be substantially completed by late 2016.
- Demolition activities began Monday October 31, 2016. Demolition work to last 1 month followed by the construction of the Multi-Purpose Field.
