Hallandale Beach's Curci House was built by Frank Anthony Curci in 1924. The house is a large Italian Renaissance Villa, revealed by the Romanesque arches along the front façade that suggests an Italian loggia and the balustrade atop a full-story balcony. The structure is two-story home built of concrete and hollow clay brick with stucco finishing. Originally the interior had five bedrooms and includes a large ceramic mural over the finishing. Originally the interior had five bedrooms and includes a large ceramic mural over the fireplace on the inside of the home with Frank Anthony Curci's initials carved into a tile. The house also has a basement, which is unusual for South Florida.
