- **Minority Development and Empowerment, Inc.** – Helps to employ unemployed Hallandale Beach residents.
- **Julian Santopolo** – Student at Hallandale High School who has performed over 300 community service hours throughout the City of Hallandale Beach.
- **Edith Smith** – A retired teacher with over 30 years of teaching experience in the Broward County School System; mentor to many youths in the Hallandale Beach community.
- **Keyla Calderon** – Participated at a tutor in the school's bilingual program; has volunteered her time after school to assist teachers with classroom related tasks.

- **Lorraine Johnson** – A longtime resident of the City and worked tirelessly helping residents; a dedicated member of Ebenezer Baptist Church; picks up food from Pompano to South Miami in an effort to feed the needy in Hallandale Beach.
- **Evenie Sam** – An exemplary student at Hallandale High School; well organized and has the ability to mentor other students and maintain a 3.0 GPA; has earned almost 400 community services hours by helping teachers and students.

After discussion and a unanimous decision by the board members, William Julian was nominated for the 2012 Martin Luther King Jr. Humanitarian Award.
