NOTICE OF GENERAL ELECTION AND SAMPLE BALLOT**

Notice is hereby given that the City of Hallandale Beach will hold a Municipal Election on **Tuesday, November 3, 2020**, for the purpose of filling Mayoral Seat, Commission Seat #3 and Seat #4 each for a four (4) year term set to expire on Tuesday, November 3, 2020. All qualified electors residing in the City shall be entitled and permitted to vote in such election. The polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. Please refer to your voter identification card to determine your voting precinct and your polling place location. Florida law requires voters to show identification with your picture and signature or you will be required to complete an affirmation in order to vote. Additionally, if you registered by mail and are a first time voter you may be required to present additional identification to comply with the Federal Help America Vote Act.
