10 11 12	WHEREAS, Section 163.3177(3), Florida Statutes, and the City of Hallandale Beach's Comprehensive Plan Capital Improvement Element require that a five-year schedule of Capital Improvements projects be maintained annually; and
13 14 15	WHEREAS, the intent of the Capital Improvements Program is to act as a guide to delineate the capital projects necessary to meet the overall needs of the City of Hallandale Beach; and
16 17	WHEREAS, the Capital Improvements Program is an effective planning tool for the City Commission, management staff, and the public in the evaluation of the City's future needs; and
18 19 20 21	WHEREAS, the adoption of the Capital Improvements Program is in keeping with the City's Comprehensive Plan, Policy 1.1.4 of the Capital Improvement Element, which states Capital Improvement needs for each individual element of the Comprehensive Plan must be aggregated and listed within the Capital Improvements Element.
22 23	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA THAT:
24 25	<u>SECTION 1</u> . The Capital Improvements Program for Fiscal Year (FY) 2021 through FY 2025, attached as Exhibit "A" hereto and made a part hereof, be and the same is hereby adopted
26 27 28 29	SECTION 2. The first fiscal year (FY 2021) of the Capital Improvements Program is hereby approved as the capital budget of the City of Hallandale Beach in accordance with the Capital Improvements Element of the City's adopted Comprehensive Plan. Actual project authorization and appropriation are subject to approval in the FY 2021 Budget.
30 31 32 33 34	SECTION 3. The Capital Improvements Program identifies unfunded capital projects for informational purposes and these unfunded capital projects are supported by the City Commission and City Administration in the event funding is identified, including without limitation potential Utility Revenue Bonds, Broward County Surtax funding, and State Appropriation Gran funding.
35 36 37	SECTION 4. All ordinances or portions of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Hallandale Beach in Conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be repealed to the extent of such conflict.
38 39 40 41	SECTION 5. Should any provision of this ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part declared to be invalid.

42	SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
